

Humble ISD Council of PTAs High School Senior Scholarship Application

The Humble ISD Council of PTAs will provide funding each academic year for scholarships for a minimum of two graduating high school seniors in Humble ISD. The amount of each scholarship will depend upon the funds available.

PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

To support students who are focused on achieving career goals, through higher education and who have been involved in community service. In evaluating each application, the Scholarship Committee will also consider participation in school activities and scholastic merit.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- *Applicant must be a graduating high senior from a public high school in Humble ISD.
- *Applicant will have a GPA of 2.5 or its equivalent (letter of verification required).
- *Applicant or applicant's parent/guardian must be a member of a local PTA/PTSA in good standing (copy of current membership card MUST be attached or signed affidavit affirming membership by the local PTA President).
- *Applicant must plan to be enrolled full-time in an accredited college or university or a technical institute.
- *Applicant must not be in the immediate family or a member of the Humble ISD Council of PTAs Scholarship Committee.
- *Completed application and required paperwork must be emailed to scholarship@humblecouncilofptas.com by March 31st 11:59pm. No late applications will be considered.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify for this scholarship the application must be accompanied by the following:

- *A type-written, double spaced 250-300 word essay to the following statement: **How PTA has impacted my life...**
- *On a separate page, also type-written & double spaced, list three extracurricular activities during your high school years about which you are most proud, with a brief description of why you selected each accomplishment. These activities may include, but not limited to, work experience; community involvement; special honors/recognition and awards.
- *A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or principal in the school you are currently attending.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, CONT.

*A copy of your parent/student's current PTA/PTSA membership card or signed affidavit affirming membership by the local PTA President.

SELECTION AND APPLICATION

The Humble ISD Council of PTAs Scholarship Committee will review applications and recipients will be notified mid- April. Scholarships will be awarded to individuals, with payments made directly to the educational institution. Applicants chosen to receive scholarship awards must submit a copy of a letter of acceptance from the educational institution to the Scholarship Committee. Upon receipt, a check made payable to the institution will be sent to the student.

Deadline for applying is March 31st at 11:59pm. All entries submitted to the Scholarship Committee become the property of Humble ISD Council of PTAs Scholarship Committee and will not be returned.
